Men's Basketball Rules/Regulations

Rules

1. A roster must be handed in at the time of registration and finalized at the start of your first scheduled game. No roster changes can be made during the season without approval of the Program Director. All players must play at least 2 Regular Season Games in order to play in any or all Playoff Games.
2. All players must wear a team color shirt with official numbers. Any player that does not wear a team color shirt with an official number will result in the opposing team being allowed one (1) technical foul, which incurs two (2) foul shots.
3. NCAA Basketball Rules apply.
4. All players must be 18 or over.
5. Teams are allowed three (3) full time-outs per game and one (1) time-out per overtime. Time-Outs do not carry over.
6. Five (5) fouls per player per game.
7. A team may begin the game with a minimum of four (4) players, but can finish the game with two (2). No more than five (5) players per team are allowed on the court. The clock will start when enough players are present to play. A team must forfeit the game if they are not ready to play within ten (10) minutes of the scheduled start time.
8. Games will consist of two (2) twenty (20) minute halves with a running clock. The last two (2) minutes of the first half and the last two (2) minutes of the second half will be a stop clock.
9. A one-on-one situation will occur after the seventh (7th) foul of each half. Two (2) shots are awarded on and after the tenth (10th) foul.
10. Any conduct deemed "un-sportsmanlike" by the official(s) will result in a technical foul. This includes trash-talking, taunting, pushing, etc. This will not be tolerated in any league at Court Time Sports Center.
11. Early Call Rule – Refs make the determination if a game can be called early due to roughness, horseplay, etc.
12. Mercy Rule - If a team is winning by 20 or more points in the second-half, stop-clock play will not apply.
13. Technical fouls are considered team fouls as well as personal fouls.
14. A technical foul will result in two (2) shots and possession of the ball.
15. Two flagrant or technical fouls (this can include one of each) will result in an ejection from the game and gymnasium. The team captain is responsible for escorting the player out of the building. The player will also be suspended from the following scheduled game.
16. Any combination of three (3) technical fouls in any session will result in permanent expulsion from that session for that player.
17. A forfeit of two or more games by one team will result in the team not being scheduled into the playoffs.
18. Players must sign the waiver to be added to the roster.
19. Overtime will be played if a game ends in a tie. Overtime play will be three (3) minutes in length with the last minute only played at stop-clock. Each team will be given one (1) time - out only; time-outs from the game will not be carried over. All fouls from the game, including personal and team, will carry over into overtime play.

Games scheduled are final. There will be no game changes.

Payment

- The registration fee is due at the time of registration. No fee, no registration.
- The full amount of money must be paid by the due date listed.
- Teams not paid in full will not be allowed to play.
- The team coach is responsible for all payments.

Waiver Forms

- Every team member must complete a Waiver Form.
- All players and coaches on the team must provide their names and contact information for the roster.

Zero Tolerance

Individuals who display poor sportsmanship are not welcome in this league. Foul language, disrespect of opponents or officials or any other unsportsmanlike behavior can result in the immediate and permanent ejection from the league and facilities.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY – WAIVER FORM

IN CONSIDERATION of being given the opportunity to participate in any basketball, volleyball, soccer, cheerleading or other physical sports activities, including scheduled, supervised team and/or instructional activities, for as long as I participate in such activities, I, for myself, my personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin:

1. ACKNOWLEDGE, agree, and represent that I understand the nature of basketball, volleyball, soccer, cheerleading and other physical sports activities, (the “Activities”), and that I am qualified, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in such Activities.

2. FULLY UNDERSTAND that:

(a) BASKETBALL, VOLLEYBALL, SOCCER, CHEERLEADING AND OTHER PHYSICAL SPORTS ACTIVITIES INVOLVE RISKS AND DANGERS OF SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING PERMANENT DISABILITY, PARALYSIS AND DEATH (“RISKS”, ALL OF WHICH RISKS ARE INCREASED BY CONDUCTING THEM INDOORS.)

(b) these Risks and dangers may be caused by my own actions, or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the Activities takes place, or the negligence of the Releasee named below; (c) there may be other risks and social and economic losses either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I FULLY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS AND ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSSES, COSTS, AND DAMAGES I INCUR AS A RESULT OF MY PARTICIPATION IN THE ACTIVITIES.

3. AGREE AND WARRANT that I will examine and inspect each Activities in which I take part as a participant of the Court Time Sports Center, and that, if I observe any condition which I consider to be unacceptably hazardous or dangerous, I will notify the proper authority in charge of the Activities and will refuse to take part in the Activities until the condition has been corrected to my satisfaction.

4. HEREBY RELEASE, discharge, and covenant not to sue Court Time Sports Center, LLC, its instructors, members, directors, agents, officers, volunteers and employees, any sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises, on which the Activities takes place, (each considered one of the Releasees herein) from all liability, claims, demands, losses or damages on my account caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the Releasee or otherwise, including negligent rescue operations; and I further agree that if, despite this release and waiver of liability, assumption of risk, and indemnity agreement, I, or anyone on my behalf, makes a claim against any of the Releasees, I WILL INDEMNIFY, SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS each of the Releasees from any litigation expenses, attorney fees, loss, liability, damage, or cost which any may incur as a result of such claim, to the fullest extent permitted by law.
